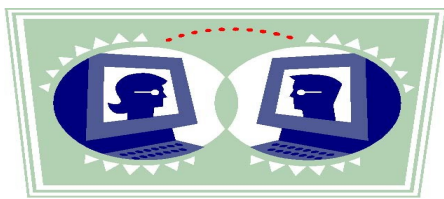

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New! August Webinar: “How to Do Business with Mission Support and Test Services LLC (MSTS)” presented by representatives from MSTs

- Nevada PTAC overview by the PTAC, then hear directly from MSTs representatives about selling company goods and/or services to MSTs, a management and operating government prime contractor for the Nevada National Security Site (NNSS) and at its related facilities and laboratories for the federal government’s National Nuclear Security Administration’s (NNSA’s) Nevada Field Office (NFO), as shown on NNSS’s website; also see on the same website that MSTs was awarded their prime contract in the past by the NNSA’s NFO, with a total contract value of **\$5,000,000,000** over ten years, if all contract options are exercised — MSTs buys a wide variety of required goods and/or services for operations in Nevada!
